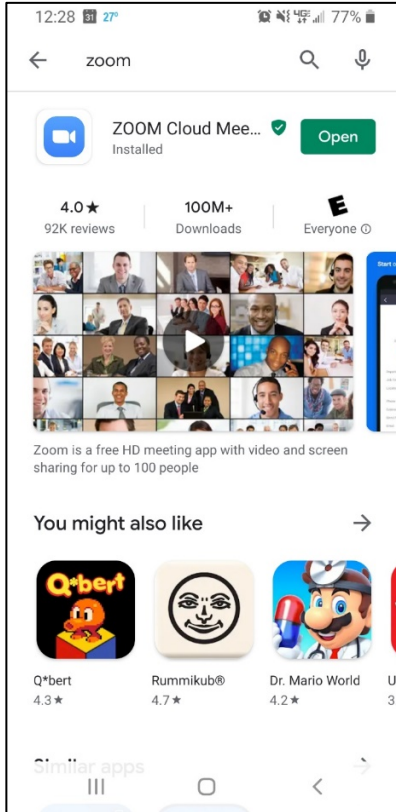




If you have not done so already, using your phone, click this link to get to the Zoom app download:

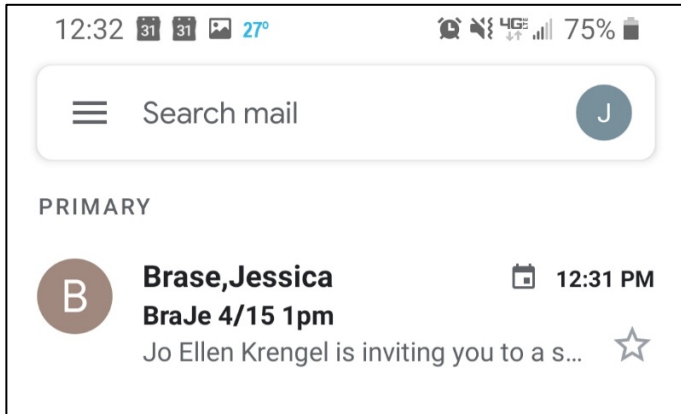
Go to the Google Play Store and search Zoom Cloud Meetings



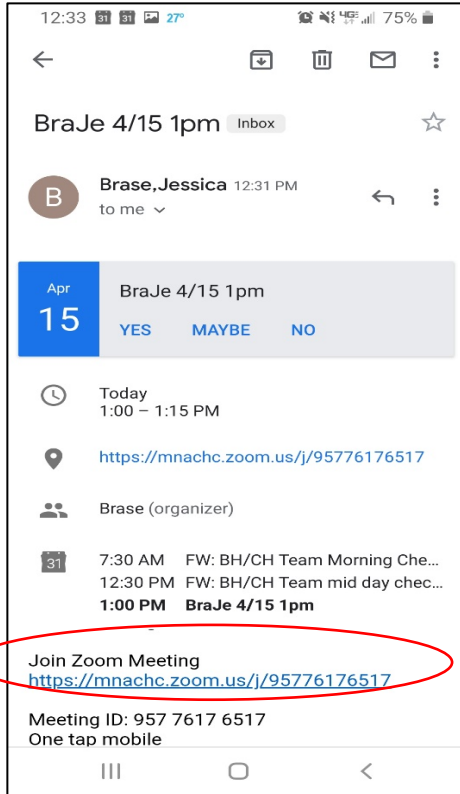
The download area in the play store looks like this. Where it says “open” on mine, it would say “install” if you have not downloaded it yet. If yours says “open” then that means you already have the app on your phone.



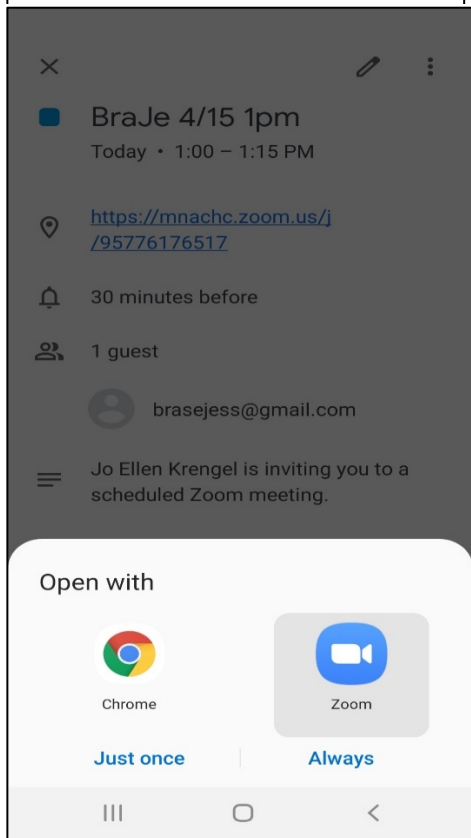
The icon for Zoom will look like this once downloaded.



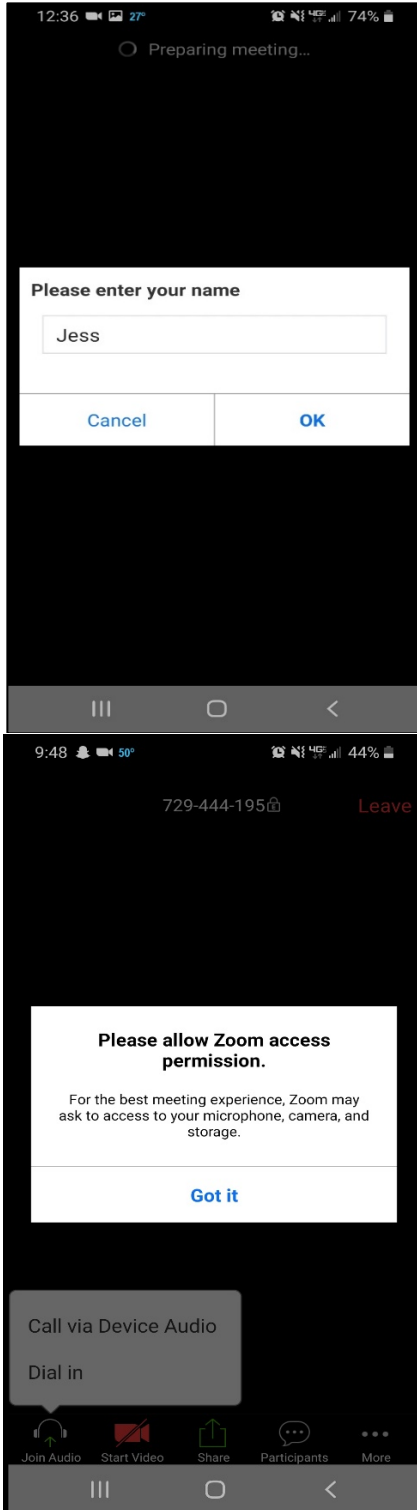
You will then get an email sent to the email we have on file



Depending on your email service provider, what is inside the email may look different, but all you need to do at the time of your appointment is click the link below "Join Zoom Meeting."

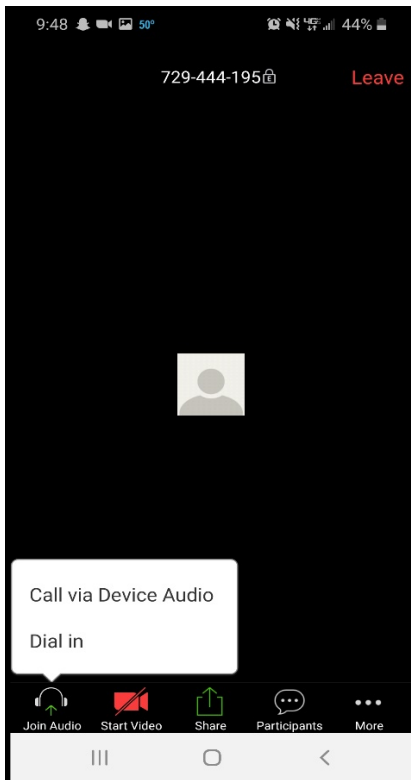


Your phone will ask you what you want to open the application with. Select Zoom and click "just once" or "always". My preference is "just once".

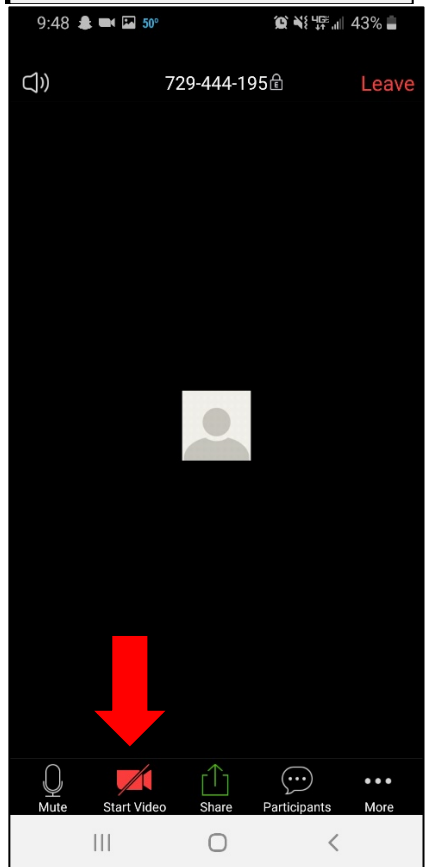


Enter your name

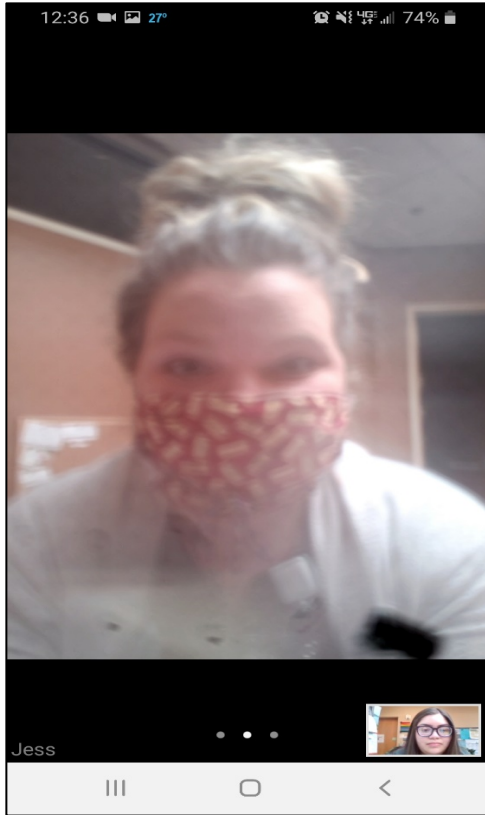
Select "Got It"



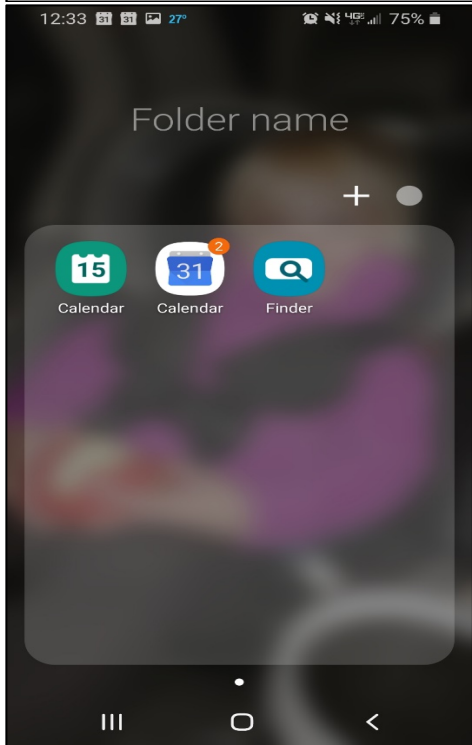
Select "Call via Device Audio"



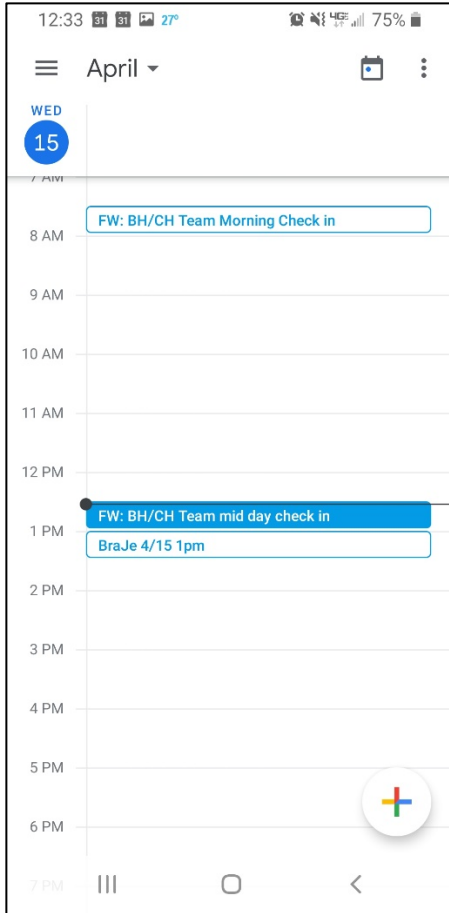
Select "Start Video"
